TCC 89th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Our 89th Annual General Meeting will be held on 11 June 2022. The proxy forms and notices were sent to all Ordinary Members on 23rd May 2022. In addition, they were also made available on our website on the same day.

Performance in 2021

In 2021, we made strategic investments in technologies to support our business and service delivery. Our core banking system has been upgraded to better serve our members, and the Board and Management team have been working diligently to enhance our system to be more resilient and up-to-date to take advantage of new and emerging technologies.



The year 2021 saw a drop in the number of loans due to the disruptions caused by the COVID situation, and along with the reduced Fixed Deposit interest rates which caused our returns from fixed deposits to be reduced significantly, these have led to a drop in revenue for the Financial Year 2021. We were still able to meet all our financial obligations and able to allocate a portion of our surplus to the General Reserves.

Our focus is always to assist our Members at every milestone of their lives and we are always thinking of how we can value-add our services to our Members.

We are happy to announce an upgraded TCC Renovation Loan that not only helps Members with financing their renovation, but now every renovation loan applicant is able to apply for an additional \$5,000 Furnishing Loan, without any additional guarantors. Please feel free to approach any of our TCC staff to find out more.

Continuing to engage our Members

We recognised that our Members have diverse interests and therefore we have setup different interest groups such as "The Clickers" for photography enthusiasts, "Women's Lifestyle Group" and "TCC Trekkers". We urge Members to join in these members-driven activities.

We hope to organise more family wholesome activities for all Members and their families to participate in, and the TCC Easter Egg Hunt which was held on 9 April was the first of such activities. We are happy to see families with their children or friends joining in the fun at Botanic Gardens.

An Exclusive Interview with MUNISAMY SINGAM AN ACTIVE BELIEVER

I'm Munisamy Rethinasingam, commonly known as Singam. I'm 64 years old. I'm retired, but I'm currently re-employed with SingPost.

I have been a member with TCC for 20 years, and a member representative for the past 15 years. I am a people-oriented person, and therefore I wish to meet people from all walks of life and to let more people know about TCC.

TCC really helped me back then when I needed an overseas education loan for my daughter to study in Brisbane. The loan amount I required was quite huge and I required four guarantors to support my application, which I managed to get my family members to help.

I stayed on as a TCC member because there is no retirement age here. As long as I'm alive, I will continue to be a TCC member where I can enjoy the Common Good Fund benefits which I won't be able to enjoy anywhere else. Even the banks don't give me these kind of benefits.

Personally I have recruited many people into TCC, by explaining to them the benefits they will be able to enjoy as a member. I had a staff who retired at 62, and wanted to resign from TCC, and whom I explained that, by remaining a member, he can continue to benefit from the Common Good Fund such as the Benevolent Grant, on top of the yearly dividends.

Moving forward, I hope TCC can create more awareness to reach out to more people, especially those who need temporary financial assistance.


