## **FOOD FOR ALL**

Ten ladies from TCC Women's Lifestyle Interest Group made a commendable impact when they volunteered to pack groceries at the Metropolitan YMCA Outreach Centre in support of the M.Y Manna programme on 10 December 2022.

M.Y Manna is a programme that supplies families in need with basic groceries and toiletries monthly. Beneficiaries can select provision sizes within a need-based budget ranging from \$50 to \$100.

Our TCC ladies spent over three hours at the Metropolitan YMCA warehouse, selecting, sorting and packing various food donations and rations. They packed bags of groceries into plastic carriers according to the needs of the beneficiaries and meticulously ensured all items were labelled correctly.

# SPREADING THE CO-OPERATIVE SPIRIT

When the Singapore Cooperative Movement held its first Public Sustainability Outreach event in January 2023, jointly


# **SEMBAWANG HOT SPRINGS**

# TCC'S RESERVOIR CLEAN-UP DAY

**OUR FIRST CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY EVENT IN 2023** 

On Monday, 13 March 2023, TCC's inaugural Reservoir Clean-Up Day was held at the Marina Reservoir. For this event, TCC partnered with Waterways Watch Society (WWS) – an independent group of volunteers whose mission is to bring people together to care for Singapore's waters and inspire stewardship for the environment.

The Reservoir Clean-Up effort marks TCC's first CSR initiative of the year, and the event saw a healthy turnout of eager participants of all ages. On the morning of the event, participants were all smiles as everyone gathered enthusiastically to do their bit to clean up our nation's waters.

Prior to the event, participants had the option to either litter-pick by foot, which entails walking along the shores of the Marina Reservoir, or by kayakand, as its name suggests, will have participants kayaking around the reservoir while picking up any visible litter in the waters.

There were sign-ups for both the 'Foot Waterways' and 'Kayak Waterways' options, so two groups of participants were









formed. Doing the 'Clean-Up' by foot takes around 2.5 hours, while doing it via kayaking requires about 3 hours.

Participants who opted for the 'Foot Waterways' Clean-Up option were seen getting up close to the waters while learning about the impact of litter on Singapore's waters and wildlife. Meanwhile, the 'Kayak Waterways' team had a meaningful kayak and 'litterfishing' expedition in Singapore's first reservoir in the heart of the city! The perfect weather on that day coupled with the positive energy from TCC's volunteers made this inaugural a successful and memorable one. Participants came away from the Reservoir Clean-Up event having gained valuable insights into protecting our precious drinking water resources.

If you have received suspicious messages from "TCC officers" asking for fund transfers to secure loan applications - be alert, that is a scam.

Deposits are not required to secure loans, and our officers will never request for fund transfers. Processing fees, if any, are settled in person at the TCC office upon signing of the loan agreement.

If you receive such calls or messages, please take the following precautionary measures:



Do not transfer any money.



Do not divulge personal information such as your name, NRIC, bank account or credit card details.



Ask for the caller's name, hang up and call the TCC office at 6319 3700 to verify its authenticity.
